
CIRCULAR ON DEADLINE FOR THE REMITTANCE OF INDEPENDENT REVENUE OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT UNTO THE CONSOLIDATED REVENUE FUND

Following the Treasury Circular Ref. No. *TRY/A3 & B3/2009* of 24th March 2009, in respect of remittance of independent revenue of the Federal Government of Nigeria (FGN), it has become imperative to issue a deadline

for the transferring of the balances in the Independent Revenue Accounts of all MDAs to the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the FGN.

2. Consequently, henceforth, balances in all revenue accounts of MDAs as at the end of the preceding month shall be transferred to the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the FGN on or before the 10th day of the current month.

3. Please ensure that the content of this circular is brought to the notice of all officers for strict compliance.
